1. Entry Fee is \$65.00 per Person.
2. The tournament is limited to 300 contestants-First Come, No reservations without fee.
3. All fish must be caught in The Gull Lake Chain. (Gull, Upper Gull, Margaret, Roy, Nisswa, Love, Spider, & Round Lake.)
4. All contestants must comply with all current D.N.R. regulations.
5. Tournament begins & ends with the opening & the closing of the scales each day as listed. Scales will be opened from 7:00 am to 6:30 pm on Saturday September 19th, 2020. Fishing starts at 7:00 am & you must have your fish weighed in prior to closing of the scales at 6:30 pm on Saturday, September 19th, 2020, & at 3:00 pm on Sunday, September 20th, 2020.
6. **There will be no trophy/award ceremony this year due to Covid safety concerns. If you place for a prize the check will be mailed to you and arrangements will be made for your trophy to get to you.**
7. Live fish MUST measure **32 inches** or more. (Mouth closed & tail pinched per Minnesota Fishing Regulations) One fish per contestant per day. Brought to Scales Immediately for Weigh-in. For all fish less than **32" in length**, Northern Inc's Officers and its Members encourage our Catch & Release Motto to ensure the sport for future generations to come.
8. Northern's Inc. promotes Catch & Release; therefore fish must be brought to weigh in sight in (Aerated live wells **Alive**) Any fish **Gaffed, Stringered, Handled by Eyes, or Otherwise abused WILL NOT be accepted**. Due to the fragile nature of these large fish all available steps must be taken to ensure their survival.
9. All fish, once registered, become part of your daily possession limit. (STATE LAW)
10. All Live fish must be transported by boat to the designated weigh sight. (ERNIE'S ON GULL) Fish must be brought to scales immediately and weighed in. **This year, you will be required to wear a mask while weighing in your fish in to protect our tournament directors. Please be nice, they are especially important to us! Only one fish/boat at a time, we know you are excited and want to get back out fishing, but take your time and do this right.**
11. In the event of a tie the team first weighed in wins.
12. All contestants under 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult. All persons must have their ticket with them at all times & must have a visible colored ribbon that comes with the purchase of your ticket tied to your boat at all times. This ribbon must be visible when you weigh a fish for the weigh master. All lake spotters must be able to see the ribbon during the tournament hours.

13. Because rules have loopholes, the spirit of the rules shall prevail. The Tournament Director's Decision is Final.
14. Northern's Inc, its officer's and members are not liable for accidents, loss, or damage to person or property in conjunction with this tournament.

There will be no rules meeting on Friday before the tournament this year. We are sure that some of you will miss this. You can still come in and get your last minute tickets as before. (If you are one of those type of fisherpersons)
